Nguyen will preside over daily Masses on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday mornings (NO daily Mass on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday). Msgr. Frederic Elkin will preside over the Saturday confessions, Saturday evening and Sunday Masses, plus Ash Wednesday Masses. There also will be no weekday Adoration (7:15 to 8:15 a.m.) while Fr. Matthias is gone.

## **DID YOU KNOW...?** **MASS BY THE NUMBERS**

Every weekend Mass at CTK needs (at least) the following lay ministers:

- ✓ 2 Lectors
- ✓ 5 Eucharistic Ministers
- ✓ 3 Altar Servers (4 on Feast days)
  - ✓ 2 to 4 Ushers
- ✓ 2 Children's Ministers of the Word (8:30 & 11)
  - ✓ 1 Cantor (at least)

That's a total of 15 X 4 Masses = 60 Ministers needed every single week!

If everyone serves only once a month, we would need 240 to 300 Ministers!

Fortunately many ministers serve every single week, some at multiple Masses or in multiple roles.
