“WHAT IS LENT?”

Lent is a period of repentance, prayer and fasting traditionally observed by Catholics and some Protestant denominations. It begins with **Ash Wednesday** and ends with **Easter Sunday**. The length of Lent was established in the 4th century as 46 days (40 day, not counting Sundays). During Lent, participants often make a sacrifice by giving something up and/or do something extra like attending daily Mass or Adoration. Catholics also abstain from eating meat on Fridays and fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday as specific forms of penance and sacrifice.

FR. MATTHIAS VACATION

From January 17 thru February 22, 2018 – Fr. Matthias will be on vacation. During that time, Fr. Joseph P. Nguyen will preside over daily Masses on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday mornings (**NO** daily Mass on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday). Msgr. Frederic Elkin will preside over the Saturday confessions, Saturday evening and Sunday Masses, plus Ash Wednesday Masses. There also will be no weekday Adoration (7:15 to 8:15 a.m.) while Fr. Matthias is gone.
